- 3. Only candidates who have attempted the NLSAT examination on 27th April 2025 are eligible to submit a grievance. Grievances against the Final Answer Key may be raised ONLY by candidates who have submitted objections as per the Notification inviting objections dated 28th April, 2025.
- 4. Candidates may file a grievance regarding the NLSAT 2025 scorecards and offers for admissions.
